

TBAC NIGP Buyer/Seller Golf Tournament Guidelines



General

The purpose of this tournament is to bring government agency procurement professionals together with the vendors and suppliers in the region to network and connect. The event is an opportunity for golfers to enjoy a fun, relaxing round of golf at a Tampa Bay area course while fundraising in support of our Tampa Bay Area Chapter of the National Institute for Government Procurement.

Event Coordination

The incoming Chair will solicit Tampa Bay area golf courses for quotes to present to the Board for approval. Any contracts, deposits, terms and conditions must be approved by the Board prior to reserving the date and course.

The event is typically held in May, but the Chair must plan for a Friday morning start time and consider other chapter and industry events that members and vendors may be attending. This will ensure volunteer and attendee availability.

Volunteers and attendees must adhere to the course dress code for attire at the event and follow all proper golf etiquette.

Committee Member Roles & Responsibilities

The committee will be comprised of subcommittees to perform specific tasks/assignments for the event to ensure a comprehensive and successful event for the sponsors and players. Committee member roles and responsibilities are described in the table below. All volunteers may be required to assist with any aspect of the event as deemed necessary by the committee Chair or Co-Chair.

Volunteers will be chosen through chapter membership survey and approved by the Board.

	Golf Tournament Committee Chair will serve one year.
Chair	Manage event. Act as liaison to course personnel. Create timeline and manage deadlines for event planning and success. Plan and hold committee meetings and administer progress of event planning.
Co-Chair	Assist Chair with coordination and meetings as necessary for event planning and administration. Two-year commitment with succession to Chair in second year.
Registration & Sponsorships (Chair plus 6 volunteers)	Registration subcommittee will be comprised of six or more individual volunteers. Collect all fees for registration, sponsorships, games, advantages and raffle sales. Monitor online registration and report numbers to Chair weekly. Work with Communications Chair to send out email notification and updates. Keep log of players. Greet and assist on day of tournament. Player Goody Bag collection & assembly.
Games, Advantages (Chair plus 8 volunteers	Games, Advantages and other associated activities as deemed by the committee will be coordinated and administered by eight or more volunteers. Sell wrist bands, money ball (group) or tickets for games at start of play. Work the stations as needed. Responsible for log of winners and revenue.
Raffle (Chair plus 4 volunteers)	Prize raffle subcommittee will be coordinated and administered by four or more volunteers.

 - Sponsorship includes: Hole Sponsorship, 4 tournament entries, 4 game wristbands,
 4 raffle tickets, lunch/beverage service
- Eagle Level Sponsor
 - O Sponsorship includes: Hole Sponsorship and 2 tournament entries, 2 game wristbands, 2 raffle tickets, lunch/beverage service.
- Birdie Level Sponsor Donation of raffle item or player bag item.
 - o Sponsorship includes: Hole Sponsorship, signage at awards reception, 1 tournament entry, lunch/beverage service.
- Par Level Sponsor
 - o Sponsorship includes: 1 tournament entry, lunch/beverage service.
