

Eligibility Criteria for Committee and Task Force Membership

KSA Type	Criteria
Requirements	Must be a current NIGP member holding either active or associate membership in order to serve as a voting member Non-members may be appointed in a non-voting, advisory capacity as an industry leader with expertise in the discipline that impacts the work of the committee or task force Restrictions: Members may only serve one board, council, or committee concurrently
Knowledge	Working knowledge of NIGP's vision, mission, and purpose Working knowledge of the opportunities and challenges facing the public procurement profession Working knowledge of topics and issues to be addressed by the assigned committee or task force
Skills	Demonstrated interpersonal and communication skills
Abilities	Ability to participate in conference calls during business hours when scheduled by the Chair Ability to commit at least five hours per month for a multi-year period to this professional volunteer opportunity
Terms	Three years with the option to compete for a second 3-year term.
