

Eligibility Criteria for Representing NIGP on a Board or Committee for an Independent Organization

Requirements	<p>Must be a current NIGP member holding active membership</p> <p>Must meet all eligibility criteria established by the independent organization which may be revised from time to time. It is the responsibility of candidates and appointees to understand and comply with this criteria.</p> <p>For persons representing NIGP on the UPPCC Governing Board, the candidate must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold a current CPPO designation; • Not be a member of the UPPCC Board of Examiners; and • Not be an instructor of CPPO or CPPB preparatory courses <p>For persons representing NIGP on the UPPCC Board of Examiners, the candidate must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold a current CPPO designation to serve on the Board’s CPPO team or a CPPB designation to serve on the Board’s CPPB team • Be currently employed within the public sector in a procurement capacity • Not be a member of the UPPCC Governing Board; and <p>Not be an instructor for any procurement-related educational courses or for any CPPO or CPPB preparatory courses.</p> <p>Restrictions: Members may only serve one NIGP board, council, or committee concurrently; however, members can serve on one auxiliary board, council or committee while serving on one NIGP board, council or committee concurrently.</p>
Knowledge	<p>Working knowledge of NIGP’s vision, mission, and purpose as well as the independent organization’s vision, mission and purpose</p> <p>Working knowledge of the opportunities and challenges facing the public procurement profession</p> <p>Working knowledge of the governance roles and responsibilities of non-profit boards and/or councils</p>
Skills	<p>Demonstrated thought leadership skills</p> <p>Demonstrated principled leadership skills</p> <p>Demonstrated interpersonal and communication skills</p>
Abilities	<p>Ability to work collaboratively with other Board, Council or Committee members</p>

Ability to engage stakeholders in the decision-making process

Ability to participate in conference calls during business hours when scheduled by the Chair of the independent organization

Ability to attend in-person meetings when scheduled by the Chair. NIGP may be able to fund travel.

Ability to commit at least five hours per month for a multi-year period to this professional volunteer opportunity.
