The December 4, 2024 deadline applies. *(Note: you can only serve on the NIGP Board or one Council concurrently).*

The Talent Council will recruit for committee/task force vacancies next spring. However, the Council's recruitment process is 24/7 – members can apply for volunteer leader positions anytime and the universal application applies to all positions that are available today and into the future.
